



2017-2018 Feed Kids School Breakfast Grant Results

During the school year of 2017/2018, Full Plates Full Potential awarded 6 Feed Kids Breakfast Grants to support 14 schools in using proven best practices to reach more kids with nutrition to start their day. Our \$18,415 investment resulted in 23,041 new meals served and \$32,790 in federal reimbursements coming back into the state.
