



2018-2019 Feed Kids School Breakfast Grant Results

During the school year of 2018/2019, Full Plates Full Potential awarded 6 Feed Kids Breakfast Grants to support 6 schools in using proven best practices to reach more kids with nutrition to start their day. Our \$13,113 investment resulted in 45,998 new meals served and \$59,605 in federal reimbursements coming back into the state.
